- 1 Identify the literary “seams” in the composition, i.e., the indications of transition from one component of the composition to the next.
- 2 Discuss the main theme(s) of the book. What is the book driving at? What does it want to accomplish with its audience?
- 3 In what ways does Ezekiel demonstrate transformational leadership?
- 4 Are there elements of theology in the book which you had not realized were there? What are they?
- 5 List various issues that were raised for you as you read Ezekiel. How would you pursue resolving these issues?
